#### **Welcome from the Rimon Local Governors and Voluntary Contributions**

We are looking forward to welcoming your [son/daughter/children] to Rimon!

We are excited that you will be joining our wonderful school community and look forward to seeing you at various events as well as school pick-up and drop-off throughout the year!

We wanted to send a brief email to you regarding Voluntary Contributions, to explain why we raise voluntary contributions and to encourage you to make your annual contribution. We have included the link below where you can easily set up and make your contributions to the school.

At Rimon we rely on donations from parents called 'Voluntary Contributions' ("VCs") for a whole range of services and equipment which benefit our children. Rimon receives government funding, but unfortunately this funding only covers our very basic running costs and does not allow us to deliver the nourishing educational experience that we all want for our children. If we had to rely on government funding alone, we would have to reduce the extra support, enrichment and activities we provide, and lower our collective aspirations for the School.

Without regular Voluntary Contributions, we would simply NOT be able to pay for:

- **Teaching Assistants** there is no government funding for Teaching Assistants beyond Year 2 unless a child has an Educational Health and Care Plan (EHCP) and even those are very rarely fully funded by the government
- **Technology equipment** e.g. chrome books which are not funded by the government and have to be replaced
- Kodesh Staff we are a Jewish school. Our Kodesh provision is funded solely through VCs
- **Curriculum resources** –White Rose for Maths, the Power of Reading for English, Spelling Frame, Times Table Rockstars and others are all paid for with VCs
- **Staff Training** we want our teachers to grow, develop & improve so they know how to get the best out of our children
- Enrichment Activities visiting performers, inspiring speakers, subsidised school trips, specialist PE teaching and Maccabi and Barnet sports participation are all funded through VCs

All of these extras make our children's experience at Rimon as rich and fulfilling as possible. Below is a link to a brief video that we produced for our last Fundraising dinner in 2019 (before we were joined by Mrs Sarah Simmons) to give you a sense of what we offer at Rimon and why voluntary contributions are so important.

Reducing the quality and depth of our provision for the children is just not an option, which is why we ask those who are able to contribute (or can ask family members to assist with contributions) to do so. As a result of these contributions - on which we rely so heavily - Rimon is able to maintain consistently high standards of education and enrichment for all pupils.
